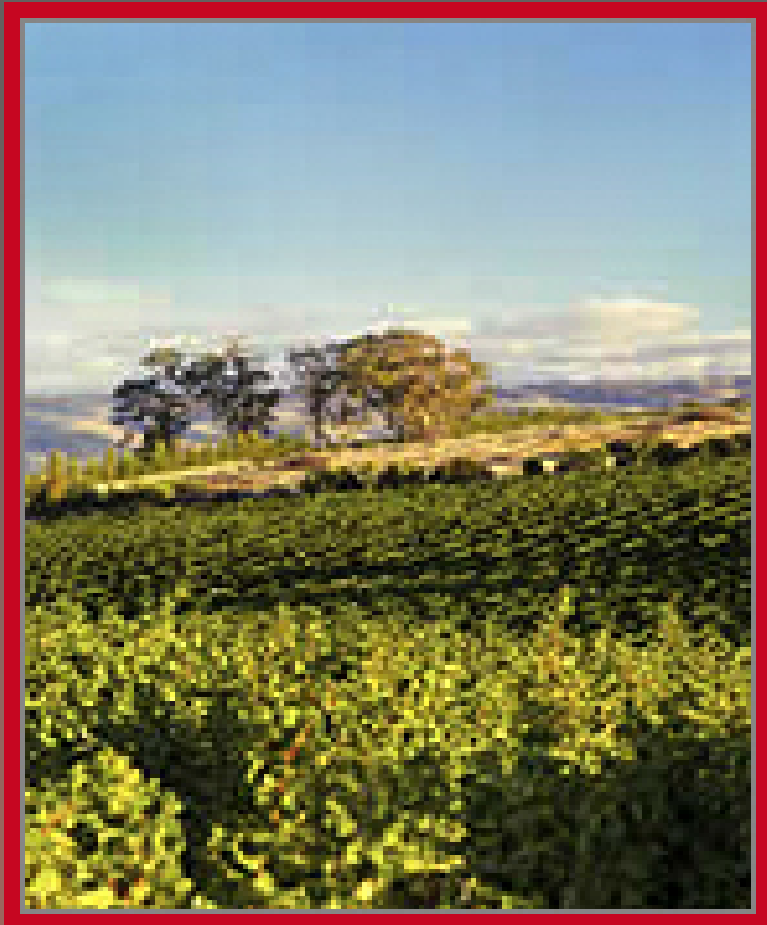

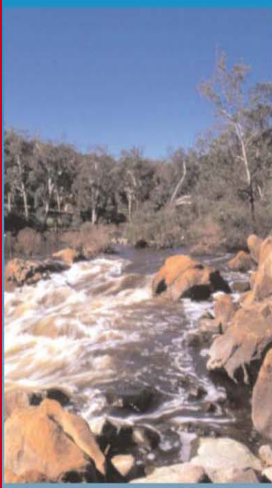

McLaren Vale



Slightly cooler spring than usual followed by a long mild summer and numerous healthy downpours enabled the vineyards to retain almost perfect natural balance. The resulting wines are characterized by their balance and finesse rather than brute power, although most will have more than enough natural acid and tannin to ensure a long prosperous life in the cellar.

Maturation – 11 months in combination of French 225 and 500 litre barrels. Approx 20% Lifted aromatics of spice and red fruits, strong mid palate with typical varietal characteristics

Cellaring Potential – 8 - 10 years



2007 Eden Valley Loomwine Riesling



Site – 45 year old Single Vineyard, NE facing slope with red loam over rocky outcrops

Vintage – Perfect conditions through flowering ensured an even berry set although extremely hot and dry conditions made for widespread vine stress and leaf fall later. The early picked fruit from well managed vineyards have produced the best results from 2007, reinforcing the status of the mature low yielding blocks such as this

- Pronounced aromas of citrus are underlined by a pungent minerality that dominates the middle palate. The wine finishes with pure, crisp acid that ensures the vibrancy of the style is embraced

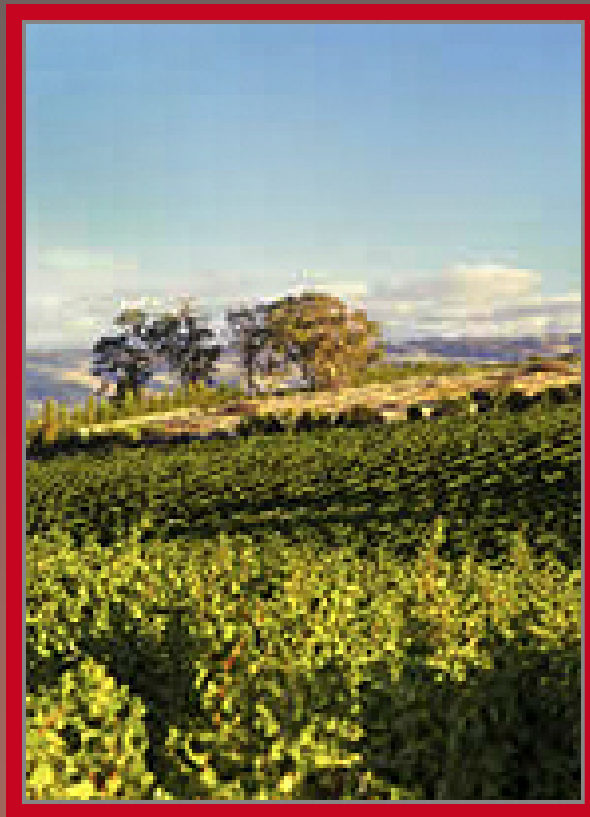

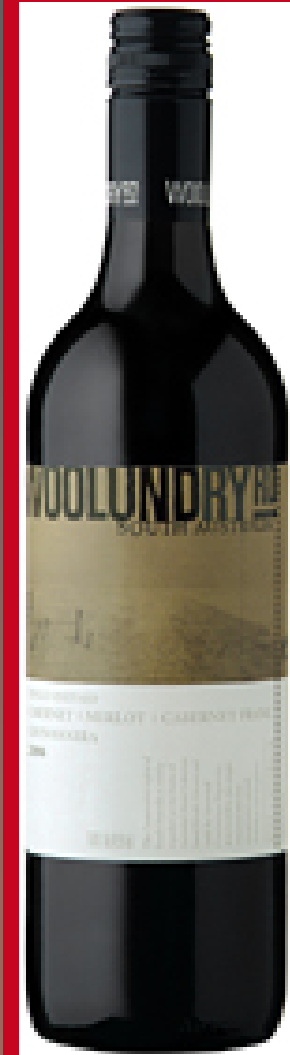

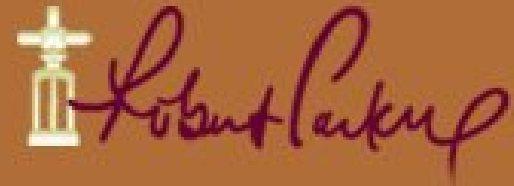

- *American Estates Wines (AEW) began operating in 1985 as a selector and marketer of single vineyard and small estate California wineries. It introduced many of these brands to Metro New York, and later to the surrounding Northeastern states. Over the years it has established a working relationship with many key accounts in this region.*
- *In 1986, AEW began importing wine from New Zealand and Australia and in 2007, Spain was added. For New Zealand wines, that makes it the oldest company continuously importing into the USA.
